In 2008, we gained title to five acres of land between our track and Highway 58 at Burchfield Road, for a station/museum building. We have a grant of \$480,000 from the state of Tennessee for most of the museum's construction cost, but it is contingent on our raising approximately \$120,000 in matching funds.

To create a world-class railroad museum that will benefit East Tennessee will require assistance from both individuals and corporations. We hope to raise enough money for the station, as well as establish an endowment to ensure the Museum's continued existence.
